COURSE OVERVIEW

Algebra 2a is a single trimester class for 1/2 math credit. Algebra 2 is the third class in the standard math sequence at MEHS. The class begins with a quick review of Linear Functions and then moves to Quadratic, Exponential, Logarithmic, Power, Rational and Radical functions. Other topics include Probability and Statistics with some Trigonometry and Pre-Calculus that is introduced as time allows. As in Algebra 1, Algebra 2 is divided into 2a and 2b.

<u>DORMWORK (homework)</u> assignments will average about 4-5 per week. These will be problems from our textbook and extra practice packets that I provide. These assignments are chosen to best prepare you for the guizzes and tests.

<u>Quizzes</u> will be given once or twice per chapter before the test. Quizzes and tests will be announced in advance. Quizzes will be short and are designed to assess whether you are keeping up. Quizzes may be retaken an unlimited number of times BEFORE the unit test. <u>Tests</u> may NOT be retaken. The final exam grade may be averaged with a low test score if a student wishes to raise their grade.

<u>Final</u> will be comprehensive and is worth one (1) test. A practice final will be supplied in advance.
