- Manage medication (prescription and OTC)
- Walk-in clinic in the mornings until 9:40am (2nd hour)
 - Nurse will triage
 - Can schedule with Kristen or PA Cora Kuhns, emergency department
- Range of services, the kind they would get at a primary care center
 - Pain management
 - Birth control, std,
 - Specialty clinics - as they come
- Very conveniently located - right next to SEARHC
 - Dental
 - Eye
 - Labs, x-rays
- Physical therapist 2-3x per week
 - Works right out of the gym
- New COVID Booster clinic - bivalent
 - Completed initial 2-dose series
 - Completed initial 2-dose series and booster
 - Monday, October 10th - clinic
 - To Opt OUT - reach out to the clinic by replying or calling Student Health
 - Only sent to the eligible students
 - Let us know by tomorrow if you don't want your kids to get it
